WV 420.12(g)(6)

WV420.12 Responsibilities of SCS supervisors and employees.

- (e) Area Conservationists shall be responsible for:  
implementing the safety program in their areas; meeting with area safety officer on semi-annual basis to review and discuss safety needs and ensuring that all supervisors in their administrative area provide for safety training of employees.
- (f) Supervisory employees are responsible for the training of employees and motivating employees to: be aware of and to abide by the safety rules as they apply to personal and public safety.
- (g) The State Office and Area Safety Officers will:
  - (1) Serve as a member of the Safety Program and Policy Committee.
  - (2) Arrange for and/or conduct safety presentations at designated staff meetings.
  - (3) Maintain liaison with State and Area Conservationists as appropriate on matters pertaining to safety in developing, implementing, and maintaining a safety program.
  - (4) Gather information from and disseminate information to all employees designed to improve and implement the safety program.
  - (5) Assist supervisory employees in the training of employees.
  - (6) Assist supervisory employees in the performance of and evaluation of annual fire and safety inspections.
