WV420.149 Corrective actions.

- (a) (7) Frequency of accidents is a valid point for disciplinary action. Disciplinary action can range from a letter of reprimand to removal from employment.
- (c) In cases of preventable accidents the need for disciplinary or other corrective action will be based on the recommendation of the Accident Review Committee. This action can include but is not limited to the Drivers Safety Series Correspondence course, news articles for News and Views and personal interviews with SAO and/or STC.
- (d) Any employee involved in a preventable accident shall write an article for the Safety Newsletter regarding accident prevention.
- (e) Any employee who is involved in three (3) preventable accidents within a year will be required to complete the defensive driving course (DDC8) within thirty (30) days of notification of the last preventable accident.
